1. 8th graders who are interested in running for ASB President, Vice President, or Secretary, come to the meeting at lunch on Wednesday in Room 407. The meeting will begin early, so bring your lunch with you.
2. PE clothes and padlocks are now available for purchase in the main office. \$15 for each PE clothing item and \$12 for a padlock.
3. Counselors will NOT be meeting with students for elective class changes. If you are wanting an elective class change, you must submit an elective change form. This form can be found on the Ridgecrest website and must be completed by tonight at 11:59pm. Please note that this will be your only chance to request an elective change for the ENTIRE SCHOOL YEAR. So, if you want to change electives for any of the trimesters, you must use the online form.
4. The cafeteria and snack bar will be open before school and after school every day for FREE breakfast and lunch for all students. Breakfast is from 7:15am – 8:15am.
5. Mrs. Perkov, our wonderful cafeteria manager, is looking for students to help in the kitchen during lunchtime. All volunteers get a free snack for helping! If you are interested, swing by the cafeteria and talk to Ms. Perkov for more information.
6. Locker reminder: You are ONLY allowed to use the locker that was assigned to you. If you put your padlock on a locker that is not yours, your lock will be cut and you will be required to purchase a new padlock and use your original locker.
7. You must ALWAYS make sure that you lock your padlocks. If you do not lock your padlock and it gets stolen, you must purchase a new lock. It is your responsibility to make sure your lock is locked and your belongings are secure.
8. The blacktop will be open during lunchtime after the first 15 minutes of lunch. Please note that no food is allowed on the blacktop at any time. Also, shoes must be kept on while playing on the blacktop. It is never ok to be running around without your shoes on.
9. No skateboards, roller blades/skates, or scooters are permitted on campus at ANY TIME. Bicycles must always be walked on and off campus. If you are going to bike along Highridge Rd after school, you must walk your bike down Whitley Collins Rd. Please make sure you are always wearing a helmet.
10. If you are riding an electric bike to school, you must register it with the school District and get a registration sticker for your bike. You can find registration information on the front page of our school website under the “Recent News” section.
11. Make sure you are always putting your backpacks and belongings INSIDE of your locker. If you leave your items outside of your locker, Mr. Alex will collect them and bring them to the front office. The first time is a warning, any time you are caught leaving your stuff outside in the quad after that you will be assigned campus beautification during lunchtime.
12. Students – any time your parents drop off items for such as a water bottle, homework, jacket, etc. they will be on the shelves inside the main office. Any time your parents drop off lunch for you, you can pick it up on the shelves right outside of the front office. We do not interrupt class time to

notify you of your items being delivered, so make sure to come up and check if you are expecting something.
